Were the activities in connection with any Keep Mississippi Beautiful programs, such as the Great American Cleanup, Wildflower Trails of Mississippi or America Recycles Day?

6. Impact: Describe your Outcomes (40 points): An outcome is the beneficial effect your program/project produces on the people or issues your program or project serves. An outcome is a change that occurred because of your program or project. What community benefits resulted from the work of the business, company, association, government entity (local, state and federal) youth group, education institution, civic or non-profit.

7. Summation (5 points): Provide two to three sentences summarizing your nominee and their efforts to make their community a cleaner, greener, more beautiful place to live.
